# Extended Port Facilities and Light Dues Incentive Scheme ("Extended Incentive Scheme")

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Port Facilities and Light Dues Incentive Scheme is extended to 31 March 2018.

- 2. Registration of ocean going vessels (OGVs) under the current incentive scheme will expire on 25 September 2015. To continue to enjoy the 50% reduction in port facilities and light dues up to 31 March 2018, OGVs (through their owners, charterers, managers or agents) are required to make a new one-off registration with the Environmental Protection Department (EPD) under the Extended Incentive Scheme. The registration form is set out in **Appendix I**.
- 3. After successful registration under the Extended Incentive Scheme, and with effect from 1 July 2015, the masters or his representatives of the OGVs are required to send a notification with the required information as depicted in **Appendix II** to EPD within 48 hours after berthing to confirm that the vessel has taken measures to reduce sulphur dioxide emission while berthing.
- 4. OGVs not registered under the current incentive scheme should also follow the procedures mentioned in paragraph 2 and 3 above if they wish to join the Extended Incentive Scheme.

## **Declaration and Undertaking by Applicant**

- 1. I, the applicant in Part A, understand that the vessel in Part B (hereafter called the vessel) will be eligible for the grant of Concession under the Extended Port Facilities and Light Dues Incentive Scheme (hereafter called the Extended Incentive Scheme) until 31 March 2018 provided that the following conditions are met:
  - (a) The vessel has been successfully registered with the Environmental Protection Department for joining the Extended Incentive Scheme before arriving Hong Kong;
  - (b) The measures specified in Part B has been taken to reduce emission of air pollutants from the vessel while berthing; and
  - (c) The shipmaster or his representative has confirmed that the measures specified in Part B has been taken to reduce emission of air pollutants from the vessel while berthing by sending the notification form at Annex to the Director within 48 hours after berthing.
- 2. I confirm that the documents attached as indicated in Part C are true copies of the originals.
- 3. I understand and agree that if any of the conditions of the Extended Incentive Scheme listed in Part D(1) is not met, the vessel would not be qualified to receive the grant of Concession and the Director of Marine may request the refund of the remitted port facilities and light dues if the vessel has received the Concession.

#### **Notes to Applicant**

- (1) The Extended Incentive Scheme is valid from 1 July 2015 to 31 March 2018.
- (2) Registrations under the 3-year Port Facilities and Light Dues Incentive Scheme (the Original Incentive Scheme) launched on 26 September 2012 will expire on 25 September 2015. Vessels registered under the Original Incentive Scheme are advised to apply for registration under the Extended Incentive Scheme not later than 25 September 2015.
- (3) A vessel which has been successfully registered for joining the Extended Incentive Scheme before arriving Hong Kong and uses the measures specified in Part B to reduce emission of sulphur dioxide from the vessel while berthing will, after notifying EPD of their use, enjoy 50% discount in Port Facilities and Light Dues.
- (4) The Environmental Protection Department will notify the applicant in writing the result of the application within 10 days after receiving the application and all the relevant documents.
- (5) The names of successfully registered vessels will be put on the "List of Registered Vessels". The List will be uploaded to the Environmental Protection Departments Website.
- (6) Should there be any changes in the particulars of the registered vessel, please inform the Environmental Protection Department as soon as possible.

#### **Handling of Information**

- 1. The Government is committed to ensuring that all personal data submitted under an Application is handled in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486) (PDPO). Personal data provided in relation to an Application may be used by the Government departments concerned and disclosed among them for the following purposes-
  - (a) The processing and authentication of Applications;
  - (b) Remit or refund the port facilities and light dues;
  - (c) The daily operation of the Extended Incentive Scheme;
  - (d) Meeting the requirements to make disclosure under the requirements of any law;
  - (e) Statistics and research; and
  - (f) Any purposes relating to any of the above.
- 2. Personal data provided in an Application will be kept in confidence. They may however be disclosed by the Government to any of the following parties for the purposes set out in (a) to (f) above-
  - (a) Any person who is involved in processing the Extended Incentive Scheme; and
  - (b) Any person to whom the Government is under an obligation to make disclosure under the requirements of any law.
- 3. According to Sections 18 and 22 and Principle 6 of Schedule 1 of PDPO, the individuals whose personal data are provided in an Application has a right of access and correction with respect to the personal data provided including the right to obtain a copy of the personal data provided in the Application.
