7	1-1-2/7.11	<p>Align last paragraph and bullets as follows:</p> <p>“Class is automatically suspended and the Certificate of Classification is invalid in any of the following circumstances:</p> <p><i>i)</i> If the Annual Survey is not completed by the date which is three (3) months after the due date, unless the offshore unit or structure is under attendance for completion of the Annual Survey, or</p> <p><i>ii)</i> If the Intermediate Survey is not completed by the date which is three (3) months after the due date of the third Annual Survey of the five (5) year periodic survey cycle, unless the offshore unit or structure is under attendance for completion of the Intermediate Survey, or</p> <p><i>iii)</i> If the Special Periodical Survey is not completed by the due date, unless the offshore unit or structure is under attendance for completion prior to resuming operation.</p> <p>Under “exceptional circumstances” (limited to such cases as unavailability of drydocking facilities; unavailability of repair facilities; unavailability of essential materials, equipment or spare parts; or delays incurred by action taken to avoid severe weather conditions), consideration may be given for an extension of the Special Periodical Survey not exceeding three (3) months provided an offshore unit or structure is attended and the attending Surveyor(s) so recommend(s) after the following has been carried out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Annual Survey; and• Re-examination of recommendations; and• Progression of the Special Periodical Survey as far as practicable.”
