How to Access the World Map

The ABS Regulatory World Map simplifies this process by providing vessel owners and operators with a reliable, visually intuitive tool to quickly identify relevant geography-specific regulations, MOU campaigns, and port incentives.

How to Access the World Map

- 1 Login to ABS MYFREEDOM™ CLIENT PORTAL.
- 2 Select Regulatory World Map from the Tools & Apps drop-down options.


3 A large world map will display in a new tab.
